

State FFA Degree Application Evaluation Reasons for Rejecting

1. You have not shown that you hold the Chapter FFA degree.
2. You have not shown that you have been an active member of the FFA for two years (24 months).
3.
 - a. If in high school you have not shown that you will have completed two years of ag-ed by the time the degree is conferred.
 - b. If out of high school you have not shown that you have the equivalent of two full years (360 hours) of systematic secondary instruction in agricultural education.
4. You do not have a supervised agricultural experience program with a business and/or training agreement.
5.
 - a. You have not earned \$ 1000 net income from your supervised experience program.
 - b. You have not productively invested \$ 1000 from your supervised experience program (see page 8, line 29).
 - c. You have not worked other than scheduled class time (600 hours) in a supervised experience program.
6. Your change in net worth is greater than your total net income from all sources.
7.
 - a. You have not shown that you have performed ten parliamentary procedure activities.
 - b. You have not shown that you have given a five minute speech.
 - c. You have not served as an officer and/or committee chairman or a participating member of a major committee.
8. You do not have a satisfactory scholarship record certified by your school principal or superintendent.
9. You have not shown that you participated in planning and completion of Chapter Program of Activities.
10. You have not shown that you participated in five FFA activities above the chapter level.

11. You were not certified and recommended by your advisor.
12. You did not submit your application to the state office
13. You did not submit your records to the regional review committee
14. Your expenses are unrealistic.
15. Your income is unrealistic.

Criticisms That Do Not Necessarily Mean Rejection

16. You need to improve your participation in school and community activities (Page 10, Section F).
17. You need to improve your participation in agricultural leadership activities (Page 10, Section E).
18. Your records do not agree with your application.
19. Your records are not accurate.
20. Your application is not accurate.
21. Your application is not complete.
22. You have not shown how all your investment was obtained.
23. You have not followed the terms of your business agreement in keep records.
24. Your supervised experiences program has shown little increase in scope in proportion to your potential.
25. Your business agreement is weak.
